NC Demo's Blog Hop - Faux Front Step FUN FOLD



This card was created using the Sweetest Christmas Suite products from the 2022 July-Dec Mini Stampin' Up! Catalog.*

To recreate this card, you will need the following:

Cardstock + DSP

- Garden Green - 11 x 4- $\frac{1}{4}$ "; long edge at top of trimmer and score at 1", 2", 6- $\frac{1}{2}$ "
- Garden Green - 9 x 2- $\frac{1}{2}$ "; long edge at top of trimmer and scored at 3- $\frac{1}{2}$ "
- Basic White - 4 x 4- $\frac{1}{4}$ " (for inside)
- Basic White - 2- $\frac{1}{4}$ x 4- $\frac{1}{2}$ " (embossed for the front of the card)
- DSP of choice - 1 x 4- $\frac{1}{4}$ " (cut 2) and $\frac{3}{4}$ x 4" (cut 1) (I used DSP from the Sweetest Christmas suite)

**I used both the Sweet Candy Canes and Christmas Banners bundles (#161052 and #159993), the Sweetest Christmas 12x12 DSP (#159559), Red Rhinestones (#146924) and the Baker's Twine Essentials pack (#155475) to create the sample.*

Directions

1. Fold both pieces of Garden Green cardstock on the score lines. Please reference the photo and note that the larger of the two pieces is similar to a top folding A2 card with a little "step" in the front. The smaller of the two pieces of Garden Green are glued together on that little front 1" panel and then on the back of the card when folded flat. (Please watch the video in the blog post if you are struggling to put the base card together).
2. Attach the strips of DSP to the card front with tape runner or liquid adhesive. The little strip that goes on the front bottom section actually covers where the two pieces of Garden Green are glued together to give the card a more finished look.
3. Attach the embossed basic white panel to the front section of the card and decorate with candy canes and a banner sentiment.
4. Add a twine bow with a glue dot and some red rhinestones for shine.
5. Stamp the larger Basic White panel with greenery and sentiment of choice and attach to inside of card to finish. Don't forget to decorate the envelope, too!
